TECHNICAL COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES

EMPHASIS

The emphasis of the activities of the Technical Committee shall be directed at local technical issues, local technical projects, and local technical tours.

GOALS

The goals of the Technical Committee shall be to improve the visibility of technical issues and projects in the Metropolitan New York area in light of national technical issues and projects.

OBJECTIVES

1. To present National Technical Committee goals, objectives, and activities.
2. To encourage submittal of Technical Papers by members of the Met Section.
3. To review Technical Papers submitted by members and to select a paper for consideration of a District Award.
4. To present a certificate to the winner of the Met Section Technical Paper.
5. To review District Technical Papers for the District Technical Committee for District Awards.
6. To review District Student Papers for the District Technical Committee for District Awards.
7. To disseminate papers to the Met Section membership that were prepared by Met Section members for presentation at other conferences.
8. To disseminate information on local technical issues and projects.
9. To arrange semi-annual Technical Conferences.



10. To prepare Technical Reports on aspects of interest to the Met Section members. (Example: Met Section Trip Generation Study).

RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER COMMITTEES

1. Program Chairperson – to assist the VP of the Met Section in examining appropriate technical subjects for consideration for formal presentations at the Met Section meetings.
2. Technical Editor – to coordinate with the Technical Editor to assure the reporting of technical projects and accomplishments in the Newsletter.
3. School Coordination - to request the participation of this Committee in the review of District Student Papers for the District Technical Committee.
4. Professional Development - to coordinate the compatible scheduling of Seminars and Technical Conferences. (The emphasis of the seminars will be on the development of the transportation professional through the exposure to development concepts, management skills, and technological skills. The emphasis of the Technical Conferences will be on local technical issues, local projects, and local tours.)
