The Road Safety Audit workshop is designed to introduce road safety audits as an effective tool that can help to reduce injuries and fatalities on road networks. Road safety audits are defined by the Federal Highway Administration as a formal safety performance examination of an existing or future road or intersection by an independent audit team. Road safety audits can be used in any phase of project development from planning and preliminary engineering, design, and construction. RSAs can also be used on any sized project from minor intersection and roadway safety retrofits to mega-projects. This workshop will help local road agency professionals understand basic road safety audit concepts, risk and safety, and common issues, and all them to bring this knowledge back to their organization.
